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
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


Ask Rebecca Tomlinson what she likes best about Key West and she's quick to answer: "theater, theater!"

Ok, ok, so maybe going nose-to-nose with a 600 lb. shark is not your idea of a great day at the beach. Especially when it flashes those pearly whites at you. But fear not. At Aquarium Encounters in Marathon, you can dive or snorkel in a ginormous Coral Reef Tank amona colorful schools of reef fish and face off with giant sharks, goliath grouper, moray eels and other denizens inhabiting the adjoining Predator Reef Tank. Separated by a 6" clear plexiglass window, the Predator Reef Tank is equipped with a small underwater portal where you can actually hand-feed the sharks. > Stahl's spectacular production of the fabled ballet is rich with original Key West tropical imagery and familiar island icons.


Expect to see legions of toy sailors battling a Rooster King and his army of

• 3 tablespoons margarine, softened

smooth, creamy pumpkin sour

- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted







You'll find trinkets like those all over the Keys but they are not true "legal tender" and hold no government monetary status.

Only the Bahamian One Dollar Conch Coin is the "true coin of the Conch Republic" and is made up of solid silver with almost half an ounce of pure silver.

First issued in 1966, all of these coins are close to 50 years old and are available (at amazingly affordable prices) as striking pendants, key chain

monev clips - framed in both sterling and gold.

You can only find the "real deal" at a handful of exclusive island retailers: In KeyWest at Neptune Designs, Abaco Gold and Emeralds International: in Marathon at The Midas Touch: and in Islamorada at Ocean Gardens.

And remember: Long live the Conch Republic!





NEGOTIATING TIPS FOR CLOSING THE BEST DEAL

TIP #1: Know The Seller's Motivation.




