Mel Fisher Days July 11 - 16

ho isn't enthralled by the prospect of discovering a buried treasure? Key West's legendary shipwreck salvager, Mel Fisher certainly was.

The former chicken farmer turned treasure hunter hunted doggedly for years in search of the treasure-packed Spanish galleon, Nuestra Señora de Atocha. The doomed ship sank in a hurricane off the Florida Keys in 1622 en route back to Spain from Cuba.

Finally, on July 22, 1985, just three years before Mel's death and after 16 years of proclaiming "Today Is The Day," Fisher's crew hit pay dirt. Buried about 35 miles offshore from the Keys in less than 50' of water lay the Atocha's Mother Lode

over 1.000 silver bars.

All in all, the cache totaled over \$500 million in treasures, but that's only about half of what the family business has since recovered.

Each year, "Mel Fisher Days," which takes place in Key West from Thursday, July 11 through Saturday, July 13 commemorates Fisher's astonishing discovery.

The three-day event includes tours of the salvage boat J.B. Magruder which is currently used to seek still-undiscovered Atocha artifacts; exclusive explorations of the Fishers' conservation lab; opportunities to hear tales from the crew

who found the Atocha riches; a dock



Discovering the location of the main wreck along with its sister ship, the Santa Margarita, netted his crew more than 40 tons of silver and gold including over 100,000 Spanish silver coins known as "Pieces of Eight," gold coins, silver and gold artifacts, Columbian emeralds and

party; and a chance to win an authentic Atocha treasure coin.

It's also a time when Mel Fisher's investors gather here to party, dive the wreck site and cash in on the year's new bounty.



You see, despite Fisher's huge haul, treasure hunting is an expensive proposition so each year Mel Fisher Treasures ensures its cash flow by opening its coffers to individual investors who currently number about 200.

Buying shares worth \$10,000 to \$80,000, the investors who include divers, small business owners, history buffs, etc., become part owners in Fisher's treasure-hunting operation and get paid in silver coins, gold chains, pearls and other spoils.

But you don't have to be an investor to see it for yourself. Many of the artifacts from the Atocha and Margarita are on display at the Mel Fisher Maritime Museum, and you can also purchase your own genuine treasure coins and treasure jewelry at Mel Fisher's Treasures.

Release the Bulls! Hemingway Days July 16 - 21

hether composing novels in his Whitehead Street writing studio or fishing for big game in local waters, Pulitzer Prizewinning author Ernest Hemingway left a powerful legacy in Key West.

So what better way to celebrate his zest for life, literary accomplishments and enduring affection for the island he called home throughout the 1930s than by throwing an annual birthday bash in his honor?

This year, our tiny island commemorates the 119th anniversary of Ernest's July 21st birth on Tuesday, July 16 through Sunday, July 21 in true Key West style.

Not surprisingly, the headquarters for much of the revelry is Sloppy Joe's, which happened to be the real Hemingway's favorite watering hole.

One of the most popular highlights of the celebration is Sloppy Joe's annual look-alike contest for stocky white-bearded men resembling Hemingway. Preliminary rounds take place 6:30 pm on Thursday and Friday with the grand finale on Saturday at 6:30 pm.



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Welcome to Papa's House! The Historic Hemingway Home & Museum

hether composing novels in his Key West writing studio, fishing for big game offshore or throwing back Cuba Libres at Sloppy Joe's, Pulitzer and Nobel Prize-winning author, Ernest Hemingway, spent much of the 1930s living here and creating a powerful legacy on our small island.

Hemingway's former home at 907 Whitehead Street is now a landmark museum, and it's where he wrote many of his best-known works, including "The Snows of Kilimanjaro," "For Whom the Bells Toll," and the Key West-based "To Have and Have Not" - his only novel set in the United States.

The Spanish Colonial-style villa was originally built in 1851 and constructed of native rock hewn from the grounds. The home was in great disrepair when the author and his second wife, Pauline Pfeiffer, purchased it in 1931.

But both Ernest and Pauline could see beyond the rubble and ruin and appreciated the grand architecture and stateliness of the home. The couple remodeled the house, filled its rooms with European antiques and lined the walls with Hemingway's big-game hunting

> trophies. They also built Key West's first in-ground pool to the tune of \$20,000 which today is akin to about \$347,000.



The exorbitant construction costs prompted Hemingway to take a penny from his pocket, press it into the wet cement of the surrounding patio, and announce jokingly, "Here, take the last penny I've got!" That same penny remains embedded between flagstones at the north end of the pool.

Although he lived in Key West for just nine years, Hemingway wrote seventy percent of his lifetime works here which is considered to be the most prolific period of his life.

Following his death in 1961, an unpublished manuscript was discovered in a vault in the property's garage. It later became "Islands in the Stream," one of Hemingway's most acclaimed masterpieces.

In 1964, Hemingway's home became a museum and is now one of Key West's most popular attractions.

Today you can tour this "Literary Landmark," peer into Hemingway's second-story writing studio and meet the colony of six-toed cats who are said to have descended from the author's beloved six-toed cat, Snowball.



If you want to see something really special while you're in Key West, the Hemingway Home & Museum is an absolutely "must see."





INGREDIENTS

- 6 Large Shucked Oysters
- 2 Large Minced Shallots
- 2 Tbsp Olive Oil
- 2 Cups Chablis White Wine
- 2 Cups Heavy Cream
- 1 Lb Fresh Spinach
- 1 Cup Key Lime Juice
- 1 Cup Grated Parmesan Cheese
- 1-1/2 Cup Panko Breadcrumbs
- 2 Tbsp Salt & Pepper
- 2 Tbsp Granulated Garlic
- 1/2 Cup Melted Butter
- 6 Lemon Wedges

PREPARATION FOR ROCKEFELLER MIXTURE

Heat oil over medium heat, add shallots and cook until translucent. Deglaze with chablis. Reduce until 50% of liquid remains in saucepan. Add spinach, heavy cream and key lime juice. Cook lightly until spinach is wilted and soft. Use immersion blender to combine ingredients. Mix until smooth and vibrant green. Add parmesan cheese and 1/2 cup of the Panko bread crumbs to thicken mixture and form a light paste. Add salt & pepper to taste.

PREPARATION FOR BREADCRUMB TOPPING

Toss remaining Panko crumbs with melted butter, granulated garlic and salt and pepper. Combine well.

SERVING INSTRUCTIONS

Pre-heat oven to 350°. Place the six oysters on the half shell onto an oiled sheet tray. Top each oyster with two tablespoons of Rockefeller mix. Place in 350° oven and cook for 5 minutes. Remove from oven and add one tablespoon of breadcrumb topping to each oyster. Broil for 90 seconds until a golden brown crust forms on the top of each oyster. Plate oysters and serve with lemon wedges. Enjoy!





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

K, so here you are, ready to snatch up your own little piece of Paradise. But here's the bia question: "Which Key is right for you?" Our 125 mile-long subtropical island chain consists of more than 1700 islands. many of which offer unique opportunities for investing in real estate.

Known as "The Dive Capital Of The World," Key Largo is the first and northernmost Key of the Florida Keys and although it's only about an hour's drive from South Florida's two major airports, this funky spot is a world away and a perfect Key to hang your flip flops.

If you're shopping around for a vacation rental, ask too many questions. Here are a few things to keep

1. Don't Send Money Until You Sign Paper Never send money until you've signed your rental paper-

work. It's also a good idea to check out the person you are doing business with. Ask for references, check out their website and their track record.

2. Read The Fine Print

Is there a cancellation policy if you have to leave early? Does it stipulate when you get your deposit back? Spend the time up front checking things out so you won't have any hassles later.

3 Know Exactly What's Include

Even if everything's is supposed to be included, you should still double check to be sure there are no hidden surcharges. Most properties include utilities and gas but the fine print may say they are only included up to a certain amount.

Your rental contract should include who to call if there are any problems with the property. This info should also be posted on a contact sheet inside the property. Make sure you have a phone number and email address for the contact and get a second backup person if possible.

If you're traveling with kids, check the bed configurations. If you have three kids and the quest room only has a king-sized bed, you could be in trouble. Ask for pictures, too. It's nice to be able to spread out, relax, cook meals in, and save money at the same time.

Many vacation rentals accept pets but they may have a size limit. If the limit is 20 pounds, don't even think about sneaking in your great dane because chances are the neighbors will rat you out.

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
